Pioneer Tech's Practical Nursing program prepares adult students for an exciting career! In this program, students learn skills through classroom theory and in clinical settings such as hospitals, skilled nursing units and long-term care facilities. Rotations are completed in physician offices, hospice and home health care settings in addition to others. Graduates of the program are eligible to sit for the National Council of Licensure Examination to become a Licensed Practical Nurse.


Admission Criteria
